Clearway Clinic has a team of doctors, nurses, advocates, and staff that are passionate about helping moms, dads, and unborn babies. They are even blessed to be able to do ultrasounds. This annual banquet is for the purpose of raising funds for the organization, and their need to hire more staff. The event was well-attended by around two hundred people. The Director, Kelly Wilcox, explained that they offer pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, sexual health education, pregnancy options counseling, and post-abortion recovery. Then we watched some inspiring testimonies, showing how Clearway Clinic helped.

The guest speaker for the evening was Ben Watson, retired from the NFL! Although famous in football, he is an excellent preacher. In a nutshell, the message of the evening was clearly that life is precious and children are arrows in the hands of the Lord.



Parents are charged by the Lord with the task of sharpening them! A family where the *father* is a daughter’s first love and a son’s first hero is a godly family. Most of today’s problems stem from fatherless homes. Dr. Scott Lively, our founder, always said that society’s problems come from not following God’s order in all things!

Clearway Clinic is dedicated to helping people do just that, by supporting moms and dads through a pregnancy, protecting the unborn babies, and encouraging families with God’s help. Springfield is their mission field – where 50 kids a day are aborted. The mission of the clinic is saving babies and helping people to know the Creator of Life, and His mercy and lovingkindness.
