#### Liberty For All - a Commentary by Roberta D'Amico

On July 4th, we celebrate the birthday of our country. Two hundred forty-six years ago we declared ourselves to be an independent country with the ideal of liberty and justice for all. It is important to know that for the first time ever, a nation came into existence that was ruled by its citizens! It promised them liberty! The idea of people ruling themselves was revolutionary!

But what is liberty? What is your understanding of it? Many people believe it is the freedom to do what they want to do. Is that even possible? What happens when everybody does whatever they want? My actions can inflict harm on another, impede others' rights, rob them of their property.

So, we must have rules, but we don't like them imposed on us! There are two principles involved here. First, we as citizens must agree on rules and the consequences of violating them. Many rules and

penalties do take away from our liberty! The answer is self-control, which is not a popular character trait today. But it is an inviolate principle that the greater the self-control people have, the less rules are necessary, and the less self-control, the more rules necessary! This applies to individuals, family, society.

The second principle of freedom is "whose rules?" If everyone wants to make their own rules, there is chaos. If there are different sets of rules, there is conflict. Self-government works well when there is a common ground of basic beliefs. America was founded on common beliefs – the Ten Commandments and the Bible. President John Adams believed that only a godly people can self-govern, saying that our government of the people "is wholly inadequate for any other."

So, how to have liberty? Teach self-control, responsibility, and trust God!

## Mission Pioneer Valley Holds 8th Trust Jesus Unity Service - May 29, 2022

Normal isn't coming back – Jesus is! And to get ready for the Coming of our Lord and Savior, and His Kingdom, God is directing us to come together with other churches who have like faith in Jesus and in the Bible. This is basically the purpose of Mission Pioneer Valley and the frequent Unity Services.

The last Unity Service was January 2022, which was the 7<sup>th</sup> one, with the focus on starting the year with prayer and trust in God. Now, four months later, we have come together for the 8th Unity Service with other churches to pray for revival so that America will turn back to God and honor Him, our Creator, with prayer and worship! In cold weather, one of the Pastors makes arrangements to use their church building, but now that warm weather has come, we had the recent Unity Service outdoors at Pastor Thee's church, Bethany Assembly of God in Agawam. It was May 29, at 5 p.m., on a beautiful warm evening.

The service was begun with gospel music led by a group of musicians from several churches, then with prayer and scripture read from Isaiah 43:18-21, foretelling how God is doing a new thing! The first message was to God's people, how God warns us when He is about to do something! But often we do not hear His voice! We need to let go of what we want and let God do what He is doing. Also, in our darkened human way we try to hide what we are doing from God – like harboring bitterness and

malice, instead of being kind to one another, forgiving one another. Let all this go – in order to see and hear from God. Then we can be ready for what God is going to do! He has future plans, good plans!

In the Bible, God gives us two choices – to choose life, choose Jesus, because to choose to have your own way is a choice that leads to death. Turn away from the past – receive God's promises for the future. God wants our hearts. It's not about our worldly successes, or professions, even our age! Let it all go! God is doing a new thing – in our lives – in our hearts. We need to re-commit ourselves to Jesus – our time, our money, our plans, and especially our prayers! If we study revivals of the past we can learn much, but know that God does not do things the same way twice!

Right now, New England may seem like a 'wilderness', but God's grace and power can spring forth. He wants us to be so filled with the Spirit that He will spill over onto our families, neighbors, churches, and bring them together in Unity!
