Psalms 50:15 (KJV) " And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me."

From the time we are children, we learn that there are certain people who we can call on when we need help. As children, we first look to our parents or guardians for help with many things. Whether we're hungry, have fallen and scraped a knee, need a ride to an event, or need other material things, we have expectations that calling on a parent or guardian will get us what we need.

As we continue to mature, we learn that our parents are not the only ones we can call on for help. Who we call for help, really depends on the type of help we need. For example, we call on teachers to help us learn, firefighters if we need help putting out a fire, doctors when we are sick, or dentists when we have problems with our teeth. We learn that we should call the plumber if we're having problems with the pipes in our homes, or electricians if there's a problem with the electricity. We understand when it's appropriate to call on beauticians, barbers, mechanics, and lawyers. Each of them can help us in some way.

Yet, with so much help available, it only works if we know which one we should access for the situation we're facing. If we're experiencing pain in our bodies, contacting all of the firefighters in the world won't help

us. If we're having problems with our teeth, what good will it do for us to call the police? Not only must we choose the appropriate helper, but that helper has to be available when needed. Of course, people are unpredictable. They can't be everywhere at the same time. There will certainly be times when they are not available even if they are the appropriate source for <u>help</u>.

Yet, there is One who doesn't have any of the limitations of our earthly helpers. He is not limited to offering only one type of help. He is not restricted to helping only at certain times. He is not limited in knowledge and understanding. God is ALWAYS available. God is ALWAYS the right choice, no matter what the situation or circumstance. We don't have to go to a special place to meet Him. We don't have to speak with God's assistant and make an appointment in hopes of getting help. We can call on God at any time, and anywhere.

Too often we don't get the help we need because we aren't going to the right source. We must call on the Lord who is able to help us above all. We must put our hope and confidence in Him, knowing that there's nothing too hard for Him. God has told us to call on Him when we face trouble. He is willing and able to deliver us, and when He does, we are to glorify Him. Let's call on the Lord!
